

## Guidelines for the **Search For Peace** On-Line and Physical Exhibits, and **The Peacemaker Prize**

1. Any original artwork on the general theme of "promoting peace in our hearts, and/or in our families, communities, countries, world, and environment" may be submitted.
2. **Artworks which espouse violence or assault any particular group will not be accepted.**
3. **Deliver artworks** for the physical exhibit to the St. Pius X Office, 1280 NW Saltzman Rd., Portland OR 97229, between Feb. 1 and March 5, 2009, during normal business hours.
4. **Clearly label each artwork with the artist's NAME, CONTACT information, the TITLE of the artwork, HOW IT RELATES TO THE Search For Peace, and Price (optional). Artists may provide an additional card with this information for display near their art work during the exhibit.**
5. By exhibiting, artists give their permission for photos of their artworks and written statements to be used for promoting peace and non-violence. Artists may enter multiple works of art and may sell their artwork but the organizers will not act as cashiers and do not require a commission.
6. The organizers and St. Pius X Parish will make every effort to protect the exhibited art but artists must be aware their art works are entered and displayed at their own risk.

### **For the ON-LINE Exhibit only:**

7. Participants in the **On-Line** Exhibit are requested to complete and email, with the artwork, the **ENTRY FORM** which can be found on the web site [www.searchforpeaceart.org](http://www.searchforpeaceart.org)
8. Artwork may be emailed only to [info@searchforpeaceart.org](mailto:info@searchforpeaceart.org) with the **Entry Form** and a digital copy of the artwork.
9. Prose, Poems, or short written or graphic compositions may be emailed as documents, TEXT or .jpg files along with the **Entry Form**.
10. Emailed entries may be posted on the **on-line exhibit** on the web site and may be printed and exhibited at the physical exhibit on 8.5" X 11" office grade paper.
11. The Artist's digital photo in .jpg file of their art work could be used if they email the photo to [info@searchforpeaceart.org](mailto:info@searchforpeaceart.org)
12. Artists may be included in a small private email list and invited to show their works in other exhibits.

### **2009 Search For Peace Peacemaker Prize** (See separate page listing prizes)

- A) The 2009 Peacemaker Prize will be awarded for each of the 4 categories by the Search For Peace Committee based on the information on the Nomination Forms received by Feb. 21, 2009.
- B) **Nominations which espouse violence or assault any particular group will not be accepted.**
- C) The Search For Peace Peacemaker Prizes will be awarded at the exhibit March 7 or 8, 2009. Each nominator present at the exhibit will receive a **Peacemaker ribbon**.
- D) Nominators are invited to present a poster or table with information about their nominee at the Search For Peace Exhibit, March 7 and 8, 2009.
- E) The Search For Peace Committee and the staff of St. Pius X are not eligible to receive the Peacemaker Prize **medal** but may submit nominations.
- F) The Search For Peace Committee, at their sole discretion, may publish the information provided on the Nomination Form for the purpose of promoting peace.
