TODAY'S CHOICES EFFECT TOMORROW'S DREAMS

This book compiles life-experience stories of death row inmates – with the focus being to try to persuade young people to make good choices in order to avoid the paths taken by the death row prisoners. These stories are gathered from COMPASSION magazine.

Since July 2001, death row inmates around the country have written essays and poems, drawn pictures, and inspired others to participate in *restorative justice* through the publication of Compassion magazine. Proceeds go to family members of murder victims. Twenty-eight thousand dollars have been raised and provided in the form of scholarships, so far. Forty three issues of Compassion magazine have been distributed to help others avoid the mistakes and bad choices leading to crime.

Money from the sale of "CHOICES", and any help from benefactors, goes entirely back into costs for printing new runs of the books. So far, 1,200 copies have been printed, most given free of charge to at-risk youth in detention facilities. The per book publishing price is four dollars. All money is handled by the Peace and Justice Committee of St. Rose Parish, under the direction of Mr. Fred Moor. Please pray for at-risk and incarcerated kids, God's children who are in need of love and direction.
